## COMPTROLLER LEMBO MODERATES FISCAL SESSION AT MICROSOFT HEADQUARTERS FOR COUNCIL OF STATE GOVERNMENTS NATIONAL CONFERENCE

Comptroller Kevin Lembo will moderate a Fiscal Chairs Retreat at the CSG (Council of State Governments) National Conference & North American Summit at Microsoft Headquarters on Thursday.

The session will focus on the 21<sup>st</sup> century public and private workforces and what state policymakers must do to ensure that both the public and private sectors can compete effectively among other states and globally.

"This event will bring together state officials and innovative corporate leaders nationwide to address job growth and other critical economic issues facing states like Connecticut," Lembo said. "I look forward to moderating this event, and ensuring that Connecticut is involved in this important discussion."

The Fiscal Chairs Retreat will also address issues including state efforts to reduce overall pension costs.

Lutz Ziob, general manager at Microsoft Learning will lead a discussion on what skill sets and training the workforce should have, and what specific measures state policymakers can introduce to reach an ideal workforce.

The CSG National Conference & North American Summit runs Oct. 19 – 23 this year in Bellevue, Wash. The Fiscal Chairs Retreat session that Lembo is moderating, at CSG's expense, will be held on Oct. 20 from 8 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at Microsoft Headquarters.
