CORE-CT File Exchange Protocol

Updated: 12/17/15 – updated with new PSPRD and PSTPR links.

There are currently two methods for exchanging files with the State's Core-CT system:

1. The carrier logs into the secure Core-CT Production Supplier Portal via https to download files. The URL is <https://coreps.ct.gov/psp/PSPRD/signon.html>

-or-

2. The carrier logs into the state Secure File Transfer site. The URL is <https://sfile.ct.gov/>

This method should be used for automated file exchanges. This can also be accessed via sftp as well. We can provide credentials or can support public key authentication.

Testing Requirements

At least one test cycle must be completed successfully prior to going live employing one of the previously mentioned file transports.

The Core-CT Supplier Portal option uses a non-standard port (10400 for Production, 15000 for Test) and that may require action by the carrier's Tech Support area to accomplish this. Vendors must report in their response to this RFP whether they were able to successfully reach the portal sign on page at: <https://coreps.ct.gov/psp/PSPRD/signon.html> or if they have confirmed their ability to reach or connect to the Secure File Transfer site at: <https://sfile.ct.gov>
