- 23 I'm going to make a motion for us to go into
- 24 executive session. Is there a second?

- 19 which will provide you with that additional
- 20 information.

- 22 are going to be just the change from service to
- 23 non-service, they're going to be pretty much
- 24 automatically approved, so I'm going to read the
- 25 names as a group.
