- 4 know, we're still out until at least May 20th.
- DR. RUDICH: Okay. That means the courts
- 6 are closed? Like I don't have jury duty?
- 7 MS. CIESLAK: Courts are not closed, but
- 8 jury duty has been canceled. Trials have been
- 9 canceled. Anything that really involves the public
- 10 has been canceled. They are starting to hold some
- 11 hearings via Zoom and other platforms, and they are
- 12 still handling Priority 1 cases, which are the cases
- 13 that can't wait for COVID, you know, family matters,
- 14 juvenile matters, things like that. If you go to
- 15 jud.ct.gov, there's a notice right at the top that
- 16 says, "All jury duty is canceled for the foreseeable
- 17 future."
- DR. RUDICH: There's a silver lining.
- 19 DR. LIEDERS: All right. So should I make
- 20 a motion to adjourn today's meeting?
- 21 DR. RUDICH: Second.
- 22 DR. LIEDERS: Any discussion? All in
- 23 favor say aye.
- 24 MS. CIESLAK: All right. We're adjourned.
