- 3 MR. ADOMEIT: We'll call the meeting to
- 4 order. We need a motion to go into executive -- I
- 5 guess we need to approve the agenda, first of all.
- 6 MR. BARTH: I don't have the agenda
- 7 in front of me, but if the equity refund issue was
- 8 on the agenda, we should take it off.
- 9 MS. CIESLAK: It is on the agenda.
- 10 MR. BARTH: We should remove that.
- 11 MR. ADOMEIT: Which number is that, Cindy?
- MS. CIESLAK: No. 4.
- MR. ADOMEIT: My agenda is out of date. I
- 14 have Hartford Housing as my first item.
- 15 MS. CIESLAK: Yes, that's still the first
- 16 item. The item Bruce is talking about is listed as
- 17 No. 4, equity refunds exclusion ratio.
- 18 MR. ADOMEIT: I need to forget about it
- 19 now, correct?
- 20 MS. CIESLAK: It's there and someone
- 21 should move to amend the agenda and to remove it
- 22 from the agenda.
- MR. ADOMEIT: Okay. Thank you.
- 24 Do I hear such a motion?
- MR. COFFEY: I'll move to approve the

- 1 agenda as posted on the comptroller's website, with
- 2 the amendment to remove item No. 4, equity refunds
- 3 exclusion ratio.
- 4 MR. CAREY: Second.
- 5 MR. ADOMEIT: All in favor say aye. The
- 6 ayes have it.
- 7 Okay. We need now to go into
- 8 executive session.
- 9 MR. COFFEY: I'll move to go into
- 10 executive session with regard to all remaining items
- 11 on the executive session agenda, and invite legal
- 12 counsel, as well as John Herrington and
- 13 John Garrett, if he arrives, for whatever particular
- 14 matter he's going to participate in.
- 15 MR. CAREY: Second.
- MS. CIESLAK: For discussion -- Peter, do
- 17 you mind if we have a brief discussion?
- 18 MR. ADOMEIT: Sorry. Any discussion?
- 19 MS. CIESLAK: I want to add that
- 20 John Garrett just said hi. Good morning, John.
- 21 MR. GARRETT: Good morning, Cindy.
- MS. CIESLAK: We have asked John Garrett
- 23 to participate in item 1, Hartford Housing
- 24 Authority, and I would also like him to stay for
- 25 item 2, CMERS liability allocation.

- 1 MR. ADOMEIT: Okay. Understood.
- 2 Are we now in executive session?
- 3 MS. CIESLAK: We need a vote on the
- 4 motion.
- 5 MR. ADOMEIT: We need a vote on the
- 6 motion. I confuse easily at 8:30 in the morning.
- 7 All in favor say aye. The ayes have
- 8 it. It's unanimous.
- 9 (The Subcommittee was in executive session
- 10 from 8:35 a.m. until 10:28 a.m.)
- 11 MS. CIESLAK: I have turned the recording
- on. Please be reminded to announce who is speaking
- 13 for the recording and the transcript.
- MR. ADOMEIT: Thank you, Cindy. Are there
- 15 any motions?
- MR. COFFEY: Yes. With regard to the
- 17 Dawn Lapan matter, I move that we recommend to the
- 18 Commission that it reconsider the Lapan matter and
- 19 also recommend that the Commission refer it to the
- 20 Purchasing Subcommittee.
- MR. CAREY: I second.
- 22 MR. ADOMEIT: Is there any discussion?
- 23 All in favor say aye. Unanimous, the ayes have it.
- Okay. Thank you.
- 25 MR. COFFEY: With regard to the Cicarella

- 1 matter, I move that we recommend to the Commission
- 2 that it remand Cicarella's application to the MEB
- 3 for a final review with a specific directive that
- 4 although the MEB remains independent from the
- 5 Workers' Compensation Commission and its standard,
- 6 the CMERS disability statute requires it to consider
- 7 municipal service -- municipal service to connected
- 8 disability applications pursuant to a standard
- 9 defined by the Workers' Compensation Act; therefore,
- 10 the MEB should consider if she meets the standard
- 11 and expressly address this analysis.
- MR. CAREY: Second.
- MR. ADOMEIT: Very good. Any further
- 14 discussion? All in favor say aye. Unanimous, the
- 15 ayes have it.
- MR. COFFEY: With respect to the
- 17 Jacqueline Lawrence matter, I move that we recommend
- 18 to the Commission that it remand the Lawrence matter
- 19 to the MEB.
- MR. CAREY: Second.
- 21 MR. ADOMEIT: All right. All in favor say
- 22 aye. Opposed? This is unanimous. The ayes have
- 23 it.
- 24 MR. COFFEY: With respect to the Grzeszcyk
- 25 matter, I recommend that -- I move that we recommend

- 1 to the Commission that it authorize Commission
- 2 counsel to start working on a draft declaratory
- 3 ruling in this matter.
- 4 MR. CAREY: Second.
- 5 MR. ADOMEIT: Any further discussion?
- 6 Hearing none, all in favor say aye. Unanimous. The
- 7 ayes have it.
- 8 MR. COFFEY: That's all I have, Peter.
- 9 MR. ADOMEIT: Okay. That's enough. I
- 10 guess New Business is not on here, so I won't call
- 11 for any New Business. I think we are in danger of
- 12 being at the end of the agenda.
- MR. COFFEY: With that, I'll move that we
- 14 adjourn.
- 15 MR. CAREY: I second.
- 16 MR. ADOMEIT: Thank you, both. All in
- 17 favor say aye. Unanimous. The ayes have it. Thank
- 18 you all very much. It was a very productive day.
