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as a group.

1 There's Belkis Borquez, Bruno Delmonaco, 2 Theresa Lirette, Michelle Lopes, Sharon Moye-Johnson, 3 Carmen Propiescus, Wanda Robinson, Michael Solemene, and Carline Vanriel. 4 I make a motion that we accept their 5 continued entitlement based on the memorandum of 6 understanding that was mentioned. Is there a second? 7 DR. JOHNSON: Johnson, second. 8 CHAIRPERSON GERRATANA: And all in favor? 10 DR. GALVIN: Aye, Galvin. DR. JOHNSON: Aye, Johnson. 11 CHAIRPERSON GERRATANA: Aye, Gerratana. 12 And that's - motion approved. 13 MS. CIESLAK: Dr. Gerratana, this is Cindy 14 15 Cieslak. Ms. Hoxie has notified the Board that she is here because she is on reconsideration. She would 16 ordinarily be able to make a statement. However, the 17 Board did vote on her matter before it knew she was 18 here. And so in order to review her matter with her 19 20 statement, you would have to move to reconsider the matter, and that is up to your discretion. 21 22 CHAIRPERSON GERRATANA: Yes, I think-23 DR. GARVIN: Can we review the vote? The vote was done in public session; was it not? 24

MS. CIESLAK: It was.

CHAIRPERSON GERRATANA: Review the vote on Katherine Hoxie? Is that what you're asking?

DR. GARVIN: Okay, what do we do about the vote that's in place?

MS. CIESLAK: The vote that's in place would stand, unless you would like to reconsider her. All you would have to do is someone would make a motion to reconsider, someone would have to second it, and then it would have to pass by two-thirds vote. Assuming it would pass by two-thirds vote, then you could reenter executive session to hear her statement because it would concern her medical evidence.

And so you would reenter executive session if that would be your desire, you would hear her statement, and then you could come back into public session to make another vote on the matter. So that is - it's all within your discretion at this point.

CHAIRPERSON GERRATANA: Well, I would recommend that we vote to go back into executive session if that's the only way we can hear Ms. Hoxie's statement, and we should give her the courtesy of hearing her.
