DR. GERRATANA: Okay. Good morning,
everyone. This is Dr. Frank Gerratana. The January

21st, 2022 meeting of the Medical Examining Board is now
in session. Present are Dr. Lynn Rudich, Dr. Nikolai
Lieders, myself, and present from the Office of the

State Comptroller, Retirement Services Division are the
staff members Colin Newman, Annette Sadlowski, William

Cassada, and from the General Counsel for the

Retirement Commission, Robin Kallor.

We have been presented with an agenda. There are no amendments. We were noticed that the application of James, Erick requesting a non-service-connected disability has been changed because he is now receiving social security disability. Status will be moved to the continued entitlement pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding.

The Medical 6 7 Examining Board may ask the member questions and 8 members are called individually, but not today. I'll accept a motion from Dr. Lieders to go out of executive session (inaudible). 10 MS. KALLOR: We'll have to go into executive 11 first, but just to be clear, I know that I interrupted 12 you and I apologize. In some instances, there may not have been enough medical information to make a favorable determination. You may seek reconsideration of an initial denial. You will receive the Board's determination within three to four weeks - two to four weeks, which will provide you with that additional information.
