



Also here is Dr. Sachin 6 Parekh and Dr. Fielding Johnson. Present from the 7 Office of the State Controller Retirement Services 8 Division are staff member Colin Newman and Annette 9 Sadlowski, Robert Helfand and William Cassada. RUDICH: The Board will be making 5 determinations and voting on those determinations, but 6 would like to remind members that only the final vote 7 will be given today, not the reasons for the vote. 8 some instances there may not have been enough medical 9 information to make a determination or possibly a 10 Nonservice-Connected Disability is more likely than a 11 Service-Connected Disability. An initial denial you may seek reconsideration. You will receive the Board's 12 13 written determination within two to four weeks and that 14 will provide additional information. 15 I make a motion to deny the Service-Connected 16 Disability Retirement of Thomas Banulski. 17 DR.
