



(The meeting was called to order at 9:07 a.m.)

DR. LIEDERS: All right. So meeting come to order. The May 7th, 2021 meeting of the Medical Examining Board is now in session. I am Dr. Lieders. All the members of the Medical Examining Board are Dr. Katsetos and Dr. Dargan. Present from the Office of the State Controller Retirement Services Division, Mr. Colin Newman. I don't know if he is here already.

MR. NEWMAN: I am here.

DR. LIEDERS: Annette Sadlowski, Robert Helfand, William Cassada and General Counsel for the Retirement Commission, Cindy Cieslak.

There is no amendments to be made to the agenda. So just explain the medical Examining Board will be going into Executive Session, during which we are going to be discussing all the cases on today's agenda. The Executive Session, it is not open to the public, so I am going to ask, I am going to make a motion for us to go in to Executive Session, actually. We need a second.

DR. KATSETOS: Katsetos, second.

DR. LIEDERS: Is there any discussion? All in favor say aye. All opposed say nay. Motion passes. We are in Executive Session. I am going to ask also members of the Retirement Services Division to stay with

I am going put you back in the waiting room. The doctors are going to go through the agenda and have their discussion on each matter. When we get to your matter, you will be invited in to make your statement and then you will be put back in the waiting room, and then you will be brought back in when the doctors are ready to vote. They will go back into the pubic session and then everyone can listen to the votes on the matter.

So at this time I am going put you back in the waiting room. It sometimes does take a little bit of time for the doctors to discuss each case, so just hang tight.

(Whereupon a recess was taken for Executive Session.)

MS. CIESLAK: All right. Dr. Lieders, when you are ready.

DR. LIEDERS: Yes. Well we are now in public

session. The Board will be making the determinations and voting, but would like to remind members that only the final vote will be given today, and not the reasons for the vote. In some instances there may not have been enough medical information to make a favorable determination. You may seek reconsideration of an initial denial, and you will receive the Board's written determination within two to four weeks, which will then provide you with additional information.

So moving along, I will make a motion to approve Lisa Beaupre's application for continuation of Nonservice-Connected Disability Retirement.

CIESLAK: Any further discussion? There being 20 none, all in favor say aye. All opposed say nay. 21 motion passes. 22 DR. LIEDERS: I think we reviewed all the cases, so 23 I will make a motion to adjourn the meeting. 24 DR. KATSETOS: Katsetos, second the motion. 25 MS. CIESLAK: Any discussion? All in favor say
