

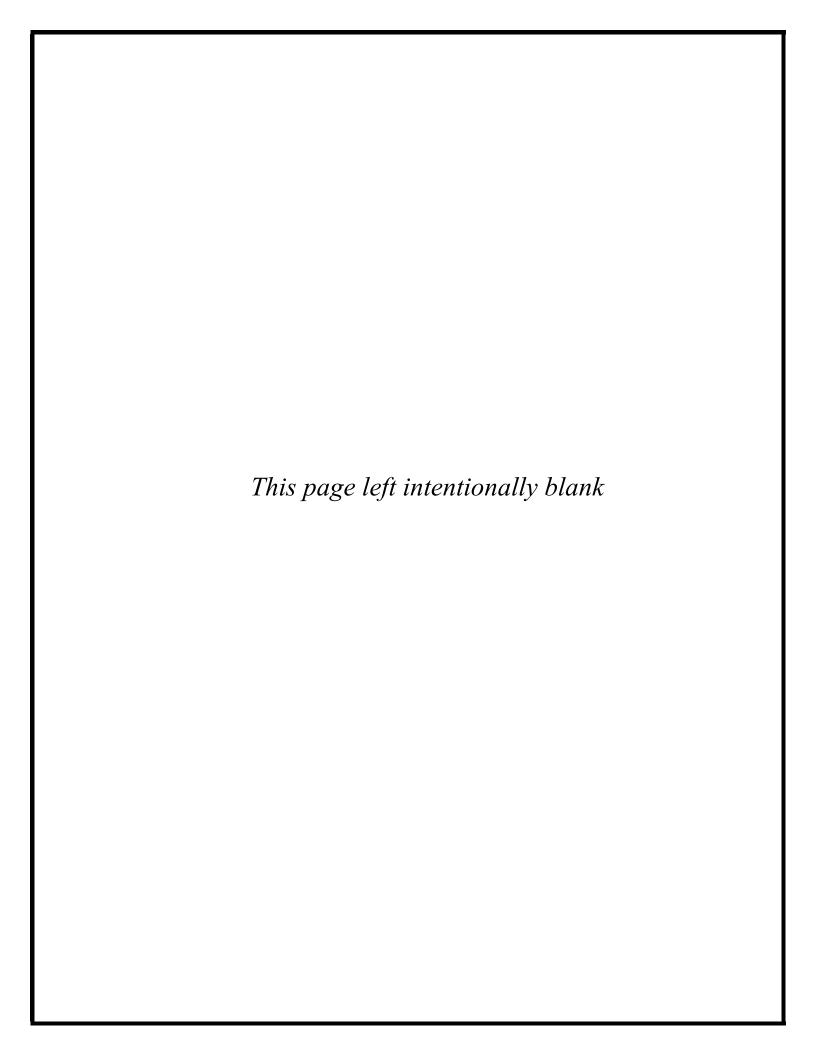

1 (The meeting was called to order at 9:03 a.m.) 2 3 DR. RUDICH: Calling to order the June 18, 2021 4 meeting of the Medical Examining Board. I am Dr. Lynn 5 Rudich. We have Dr. Eric Shore and Dr. Vasanth 6 Kainkaryam. Present from the Office of the State 7 Controller Retirement Services Division are, staff 8 members Colin Newman, Annette Sadlowski, Robert Helfand, 9 William Cassada -- is he with us -- yes. And General 10 Counsel for the Retirement Commission Cindy Cieslak. 11 There are no amendments to the agenda. I make a 12 motion to go into Executive Session, but I request that 13 members of the Retirement Services Division be allowed 14 to remain. 15 DR. SHORE: Second. 16 DR. RUDICH: Any discussion? All in favor say aye. 17 All opposed say nay. Motion passes. 18 MS. CIESLAK: All right.
