



1 (The meeting was called to order at 9:05 a.m.) 2 3 DR. ROSENBERG: So I am Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, and 4 call this meeting to order. This is the June 4th, 2021 meeting of the Medical Examination Board. It is now in 5 6 session. I am Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, Chairperson. 7 Present is myself, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, Dr. J. Robert 8 Galvin and Dr. Richard Blum. Present from the Office of 9 the State Controller is Retirement Service Divisions 10 staff members Colin Newman, Annette Sadlowski, Robert 11 Helfand and William Cassada. General Counsel for the 12 Retirement Commission, we have Robin Kallor substituting 13 for Cindy Cieslak. 14 I motion to amend the agenda, is there a second? 15 DR. GALVIN: Second. Okay. And --16 Rosenberg, you might want to specify MR. NEWMAN: 17 which amendment it is that you are moving for. 18 Thank you. So I move to amend that DR. ROSENBERG: 19 we remove Laurie Bernier and Julia Davis from the 20 schedule for today's meeting, from the agenda. Is that 21 seconded? 22 DR. GALVIN: Second, Galvin. 23 DR. ROSENBERG: Thank you. All in favor say aye. All opposed say no. And that agenda is, that motion is 24 25 passed.

1 So the Medical Examination Board is in, going into 2 Executive Session. And I make a motion to go into 3 Executive Session. Is that seconded? 4 DR. BLUM: Second, Blum. 5 DR. ROSENBERG: And that is for the purpose of 6 discussing individual member disability health issues, 7 and as Chairman I request that members of the Retirement 8 Services Division and counsel be allowed to remain. 9 MS. KALLOR: One second, we didn't vote. Just vote 10 on going into Executive Session. I think the motion had 11 been seconded. And who seconded the motion? I am 12 If you could just make sure you say your name. sorry. 13 DR. GALVIN: Galvin. 14 DR. ROSENBERG: So all in favor of going into Executive Session say aye. Any opposed say nay. We are 15 going into -- so it is approved that we will go into 16 17 executive session. 18 So that, this is Dr. Ralph Rosenberg and we have 19 entered Executive Session. 20 MS. KALLOR: Just announce who is going in. 21 DR. ROSENBERG: So, so, this is Dr. Ralph Rosenberg 22 and Dr. J. Robert Galvin and Dr. Richard Blum are 23 present for the Medical Examination Board. And we have 24 asked and invited from the Office of State Controller

Retirement Services Division staff members to remain in

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session with us, and that is Colin Newman, Annette
Sadlowski, Robert Helfand and William Cassada. And for
the General Counsel for the Retirement Commission, Robin
Kallor is present in Cindy Cieslak's absence.

(Whereupon a recess was taken.)

MS. KALLOR: The members of the public have been let in.

DR. ROSENBERG: This is Dr. Ralph Rosenberg. The Board will be making determinations and voting on those determinations. We would like to remind members that only the final vote will be given today and not the reasons for the vote. In some instances there may not have been enough medical information to make a determination, perhaps a Nonservice-Connected Disability is more likely than a Service-Connected Disability, more likely a Service-Connected Disability. You may seek reconsideration of an initial denial. You will receive the Board's written determination within two to four weeks, which will provide you with that additional information.

Attorney Kallor, shall I go through the individuals one by one?

MS. KALLOR: Yes, and then just please make sure

1 everybody who is peaking announces themselves, because 2 now we are being recorded and in public session. DR. ROSENBERG: All right. This is Dr. Ralph 3 4 Rosenberg, and I motion to approve Tammy Bailey for a 5 Nonservice-Connected Disability. Any second? 6 DR. GALVIN: Galvin, second. 7 DR. ROSENBERG: So that passes. 8 MS. KALLOR: Wait, we have to vote. 9 DR. ROSENBERG: Oh, I am sorry. I thought 10 everybody just did. 11 MS. KALLOR: I think there was a second. There was 12 a second by Dr. Blum and now --13 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. All opposed 14 say no. Measure passes. 15 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion to approve Steven 16 Bielinski, the Third for service, for Service-Connected 17 Disability. Any seconds? 18 DR. GALVIN: Galvin, second. 19 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Any opposed 20 say no. Motion passes. 21 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, make the motion Gene Boutot 22 be approved for a Nonservice-Connected Disability. Any 23 seconds? 24 DR. GALVIN: Second, Galvin. 25 DR. ROSENBERG: All approved say yes. All opposed

1 say no. Measure passes. 2 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Raul Carranza 3 be denied Service-Connected Disability. Any seconds? 4 DR. GALVIN: Second, Galvin. 5 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. All opposed 6 say no. Measure passes. 7 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Michelle 8 Costello be denied Nonservice-Connected Disability. Any 9 seconds? 10 DR. BLUM: Second. 11 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor see aye. All opposed 12 say no. Measure passes. 13 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Sonnie Council 14 be denied Service-Connected Disability. Any seconds? 15 DR. BLUM: Second. 16 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Measure 17 passes. 18 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Denise Davis be 19 approved for Service-Connected Disability. Any seconds? 20 DR. GALVIN: Galvin, second. 21 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. All opposed 22 say no. 23 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Matthew Diaz be 24 approved for Service-Connected Disability --25 MS. KALLOR: Just to go back to Denise Davis.

1 Motion passes. Just wanted to catch you on that. 2 DR. ROSENBERG: Motion passes. Thank you. 3 So, yes, Denise Davis, motion passes for 4 Service-Connected Disability. 5 For Matthew Diaz, I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, approval 6 for Service-Connected Disability. Any seconds? 7 DR. BLUM: Second. 8 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Motion 9 passes. 10 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that David Harris be 11 approved for Nonservice-Connected Disability. Any 12 seconds? 13 DR. GALVIN: Second. 14 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say I. Motion passes. 15 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Robert Ives, be 16 approved for Nonservice-Connected Disability. Any 17 seconds? 18 DR. GALVIN: Second, Galvin. 19 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Motion 20 passes. 21 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Thomas Kuzara 22 be approved for Service-Connected Disability. Any 23 seconds? 24 Second, Blum. DR. BLUM: 25 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. All opposed

1 say no. Motion passes. 2 DR. GALVIN: Excuse me, did we do both Julia and 3 Denise Davis? 4 DR. ROSENBERG: No, Julia Davis was taken off the 5 agenda. 6 DR. GALVIN: Oh, that is off. I have got an old 7 spreadsheet. Okay. 8 DR. ROSENBERG: Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, I may be 9 repeating that, but I'll do it again just to make sure. 10 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Thomas Kuzara 11 be accepted for Service-Connected Disability. Any 12 seconds? 13 DR. BLUM: Second, Galvin. 14 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Motion 15 passes. 16 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that James McGraw be 17 accepted for Service-Connected Disability. Any second? 18 Second, Blum. DR. BLUM: 19 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Motion 20 passes. 21 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that George Miller 22 be granted Nonservice-Connected Disability. Any second? 23 DR. GALVIN: Second, Galvin. 24 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Motion 25 passes.

1 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Cindy Miller be 2 denied service-connected Disability. Any seconds? 3 DR. GALVIN: Second, Galvin. 4 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Motion 5 passes. 6 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Ana Mina be 7 denied Service-Connected Disability. Any seconds? 8 DR. BLUM: Second, Blum. 9 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Motion 10 passes. 11 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Levonne 12 Perez-Sutton be tabled for Service-Connected Disability. 13 Any seconds? 14 DR. GALVIN: Second, Galvin. 15 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Motion 16 passes. 17 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Anthony Rodriguez-Jimenez be approved for Service-Connected 18 19 Disability. Any seconds? 20 DR. BLUM: Second, Blum. 21 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Motion 22 passes. 23 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Juan Sanchez be 24 approved for Nonservice-Connected Disability. Any 25 seconds?

1 DR. GALVIN: Second, Galvin. 2 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Motion 3 passes. 4 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Paul Schipritt 5 be tabled for Nonservice-Connected Disability. Any 6 seconds? 7 DR. GALVIN: Galvin, second. 8 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Motion 9 passes. 10 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Patsy Stohmal 11 be approved for Service-Connected Disability. Any 12 seconds? 13 DR. BLUM: Second, Blum. 14 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Motion 15 passes. 16 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Helen Wilson be 17 denied Nonservice-Connected Disability. Any seconds? 18 DR. GALVIN: Second, Galvin. 19 DR. ROSENBERG: All if favor say aye. Motion 20 passes. 21 I, Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, motion that Yvette Zeno be 22 denied nonservice-connected Disability. Any seconds? 23 DR. GALVIN: Second, Galvin. 24 DR. ROSENBERG: All in favor say aye. Motion 25 passes.

1 MS. KALLOR: Any other discussions? 2 DR. GALVIN: Let me just make sure, Schipritt is 3 tabled, right? 4 DR. ROSENBERG: Schipritt was tabled. 5 DR. GALVIN: Okay. Thank you. 6 MS. KALLOR: Okay. Is there, if there is no 7 further discussion, Chair, do you want to --DR. ROSENBERG: Do I adjourn or are you inviting 8 9 them back in to hear the decision? 10 MS. KALLOR: Everyone has been in. So now you take 11 a motion to adjourn. 12 DR. ROSENBERG: This is Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, I 13 motion to adjourn this meeting of the Medical Exam 14 Board. Any seconds? 15 DR. GALVIN: Galvin, second. And I'll need Dr. 16 Rosenberg's e-mail. 17 MS. KALLOR: After we adjourn. 18 DR. GALVIN: Okay. 19 MS. KALLOR: Okay. Anybody vote, can we vote on 20 the motion to adjourn? 21 DR. GALVIN: So what is your e-mail --22 DR. ROSENBERG: Is everybody else off that should 23 be off? 24 Not yet. Motion passes, right. MS. KALLOR: 25 then --
